"The press is as automated as you can buy in today's market," adds Sullivan. "We were looking for a press that would allow us to shave time off each stage of the print process. From plate chemistry and development through plate loading, registration, inking, ink flow controls and plate ejection and wash ups, we chose the Roland 500 because it saves us time. Our business model has always revolved around fast turn times. Although we don't consider ourselves a quick printer, we have always been experts at printing fast with industry leading quality. That is why our brand promise is to lower the total cost of ownership for print. The result of all this automation is faster job turn times which allows our clients to react to their changing market conditions more quickly. So clients who used to produce long runs of one document can now print many runs over time for about the same price. For years our customers have told us how valuable it is to be able to change content regularly and affordably. We are excited about being able to push the market even further with our new press".
