CCS Printing launches On-Site Print Center at T-Mobile USA

Bellevue, WA, October 24, 2006: CCS Printing Inc. announced the grand opening of its new On-Site Print Center located in T-Mobile USA's Headquarters in Bellevue.

T-Mobile's Print Center was implemented using a unique spoke and hub concept of print and document management. The center acts as a conduit to CCS Printing's main document production facility. This unique approach allows T-Mobile employees access to an on-site copy and print center and also a larger selection of commercial printing solutions. T-Mobile was able to reduce the real estate foot print required for the print center to just 250 square feet. The typical corporate copy center uses much more space, which in today's high priced office environment is expensive.

CCS Printing links the two organizations together with Web-based job submission tools. These Web tools give T-Mobile users the ability to send any type or size of job to CCS. The jobs are centrally managed at the CCS main facility and quick turn, same day or confidential documents are routed back to the on-site center for immediate print production. Larger or more complex jobs, like full color glossy marketing materials are directed to the appropriate print technology at the main CCS location.

CCS staffs the on-site center with a customer service manager who provides advice about print technologies and cost savings potential. A typical on-site center is production oriented but at the CCS Print Center it is more about a high level of customer service and expert advice.

Kevin Sullivan, the President of CCS Printing commented: "The T-Mobile On-Site Print Center represents the latest in technology and efficiency for the corporate copy center. It uses a small amount of space yet it gives employees of T-Mobile a full range of commercial offset printing and binding solutions. It's like having a full size printing company located right in your building – but in less than 300 square feet. We really feel that this is the best of all worlds for T-Mobile. Our on-site staff can focus on guiding their employees to lower total cost of ownership instead of having their heads down and working on actually producing the documents. The hard production work runs at our main facility which allows our on-site staff to really focus on what is most important - customer service."

T-Mobile represents the sixth on-site copy center operated by CCS in the Seattle area. Other clients include the Russell Investment Company in Tacoma, Group Health Cooperative in Seattle, Intermec Technologies in Everett, Spacelabs Medical in Issaquah and Honeywell in Redmond. "Each site is different," added Sullivan. "We evaluate each client based on their unique needs; however we are generating a lot of interest with this improved solution. Space just seems to be a bigger and bigger issue for companies and our spoke and hub solution is really a great way to solve the problem and improve the customer experience."
